Student Scholarship Notice: Annually both Birmingham Friends and Concord Quarterly Meeting (CQM) award scholarships for students that meet the following criteria:

- 1) Have at least one parent who is a member of the Meeting;
- 2) Be matriculating at a school that is recognized as being a Quaker school by the Friends Council on Education (or its successor);
- 3) Be in a grade from kindergarten through twelfth.

The amount of the Scholarship is calculated by dividing the number of students that apply by the money that is available.
